



Riverfront Park Rules

Riverfront Park and Parking Lot Closing Times

Parking Lot: 9 PM

Riverfront Park: 10 PM

The park is officially open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. Weather permitting the park & beach will be open the weekend following Labor Day.

Parking Requirements

Parking Fee: \$12 per day

LSCB Resident Seasonal Parking Pass: Visit/call city hall for information

Parking Payment: Please use the Payment Meter Kiosk located in the payment gazebo at the corner of 20th Street South and Ramada Avenue.

The kiosk accepts credit cards, bills and coins, but does not make change, so bring exact change.

Payment Receipt: After payment is accepted the kiosk will print a ticket. This ticket must be displayed on the dashboard of any vehicle parked in the beach parking lot, or a citation will be written.

Security: The parking lot premises are monitored 24 hours a day by surveillance cameras.

Riverfront Park & Public Beach Area Rules

Warning: There is no lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk! Children and young adults should only swim with adult supervision.

Prohibited: For everyone's safety, no alcohol, open fires, personal grills, loud music, fishing, or dogs, are allowed on the beach or in park/pavilion area.

Trash: Please use recycling and trash receptacles and keep our beach and park clean for others to enjoy.
